

How long does it take?

The exam takes only a few minutes, and we strive to have you in and out in less than an hour.

How much will the screening cost?

Insurance companies may provide coverage to patients that meet the eligibility in Category 1. Check with your provider. You may be required to pay a deductible or co-insurance amount, which will be payable at the time of your test.

How quickly will I receive my results?

You can expect results to be available in approximately two business days.

What happens if the test finds an abnormality?

If an abnormality is found, it does not necessarily mean that you have cancer. Small nodules and other abnormalities are found in about 1 in 5 screening CT scans. Most of these do not turn out to be cancer, but may require more testing (which may be covered by insurance). Your Nurse Navigator will be available to discuss the results and help you plan your next steps.



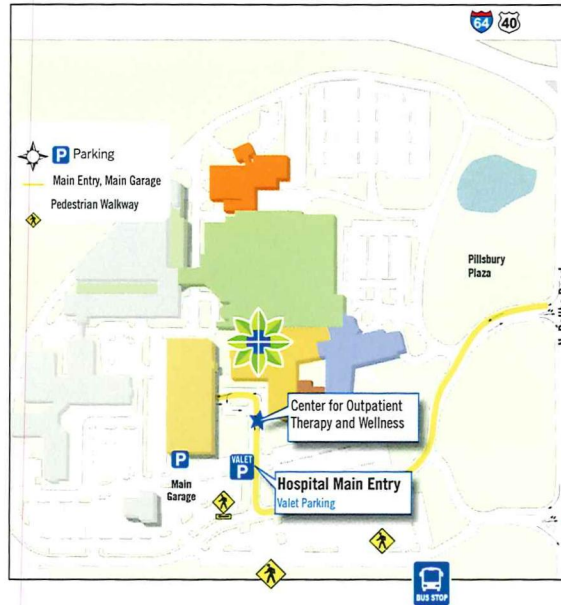

To set up an appointment for a lung cancer screening test, call 855-399-LUNG (5864) and speak to our Nurse Navigator to set up a lung screening CT exam.
